Lamar Outdoor a Spokane based billboard company has offered to feature Crime Stopper fugitives as a public service to law enforcement agencies in our region. Lamar offers this service to Crime Stopper groups in other states as well. The Coeur d'Alene Police Department submitted the first fugitive that will be featured locally on Lamar's 6 digital boards as space is available, starting today. One of the boards is in Kootenai County and five are in Spokane.

Lamar has worked with law enforcement agencies across the nation for several years by offering free bill board space in the event of an Amber Alert. Children have been located as a result of the billboard advertisement. They provide a very valuable public service.

Crime Stoppers of the Inland Northwest is a civilian group with a board of directors in Spokane and a board of directors in Kootenai County that offer rewards for crime tips to help law enforcement solve crimes.

The fugitive featured on the bill board is Brian Nordlof. Nordlof has a history of eluding police, battery and drugs. He is currently wanted on a parole violation warrant issued by the Idaho department of Corrections. Crime Stoppers is offering a cash reward for information leading to his arrest.
