"There's a huge gap in translation," Jack said. "Every horse understands this langue and how they use their body to move."

Jack's goal is to teach humans this language so they can clearly ask their horse to work.

Jack and Rich won last year's Trainers' Challenge, a competition to train a young horse during the weekend.

This year four local trainers will compete to teach several advanced maneuvers to young horses with no more than 40 rides. It's like a **Cowboy Reality Show** as the trainers show their talents by getting green horses to perform a series of advanced skills in just three days.

Each trainer gets three sessions during the weekend to prepare and school their horse. The Trainers' Challenge Competition is judged by Gail Silkwood of Moscow.
