2. I am employed as a police officer for the City of Spokane Police

Department (SPD). I currently hold the rank of Detective and work in the Major

Crimes Unit. I was in the same assignment in March 2006.

3. Det. Ferguson was the scene investigator involving Otto Zehm and a struggle with the police. On the night of March 18, 2006, I processed the scene of the struggle, documenting evidence, directing photographs, arranging scene mapping, and collecting evidence. I interviewed several witnesses who were still on the scene.

During the following weeks, I interviewed several more witnesses. Det.

Marske from the County Sheriff's Office was my shadow for this investigation.

- 4. I believe that all of my actions were lawful and appropriate in this investigation. Nevertheless, I have known that I could be named as a defendant in a lawsuit by the Zehm estate against the City and police officers because their lawyers have made accusations against the police officers who detained Mr. Zehm, as well as the administrators and investigators.
- 5. I have conferred with Assistant City Attorney Rocco N. Treppiedi regarding issues in the civil claims and potential lawsuit since 2006.
- 6. After the Zehm estate filed a claim against the City, Mr. Treppiedi informed me that the City's attorneys were designating me as a speaking agent for the City with respect to part of the investigation because I was one of the lead investigators. I met with him and other lawyers for the City in that regard. As I understood it, all meetings were within the attorney/client privilege. The lawyers

the basic concept to me.7. I was subpoenaed to testify before a Grand Jury by Assistant U.S.

said the designation was under a rule I was not familiar with, but they explained

- Attorney Timothy Durkin. I was prepared to testify fully and truthfully about the Otto Zehm investigation.
- 8. In late March or early April 2009, Detective Marske was summoned to the U.S. Attorney's Office for an interview. Det. Marske took with him his notes concerning everything we did. Mr. Durkin confronted Det. Marske, telling him he believed I filed false reports. Det. Marske refuted Mr. Durkin's claims and pointed out notes which mirrored my reports almost exactly.
- 9. In late April, 2009, I met with several city Attorneys and an attorney hired by the City of Spokane, Carl Oreskovich. This meeting was for the purpose of discussing civil issues surrounding the incident. Mr. Oreskovich told me he went to law school with Mr. Durkin and a couple of days prior to this meeting, he bumped into Mr. Durkin at the federal building. Mr. Durkin told Mr. Oreskovich he believed I had purposely filed false reports. I left this meeting believing I was a target of the grand jury based on Det. Marske's statement and Mr. Oreskovich's statement.
- 10. In May 2009, I received a grand jury subpoena for this incident. I had both the City Attorney and a private attorney contact the U.S. Attorney's Office to find out if I was a target or a witness. I was assured I was a witness only. My scheduled testimony was delayed and I was re-subpoenaed in June 2009.

I arrived in the waiting area of the U.S. Attorney's Office one half hour 11. early, as was requested by U.S. Attorney Tim Durkin. Mr. Durkin came out and introduced himself. He then requested that I accompany him to a conference room so he could introduce me to several people. I declined. This made Mr. Durkin very mad. He raised his voice, crooked his finger at me and ordered me to come with him. I told Mr. Durkin I was not a child and asked him not to crook his finger at me. I told him that he had no authority to order me anywhere, especially since I was just a witness. Mr. Durkin stepped back, took a deep breath and apologized. Mr. Durkin said that he had someone important he wanted to introduce me to and asked if I would please come with him. I agreed. Spokane Police Officer S. McIntyre witnessed everything that happened in the waiting area.

- Persons present in the conference room were Assistant U.S Attorney 12. Aine Ahmed, FBI Special Agent Jangaard and a gentleman Mr. Durkin identified as being from the Department of Justice.
- Mr. Durkin then spent ten minutes telling me how multiple witnesses 13. had given the FBI statements that were substantially different than what my reports said. Mr. Durkin told me if I went upstairs and testified to the accuracy of my reports, there was "a high likelihood you will be indicted for perjury" and sent to prison for ten years.
- I told everyone present to "pound sand" and I would be testifying to 14. the accuracy of my reports.

15. I testified before the Grand Jury for several hours. All of my testimony was truthful. I was questioned by the prosecutor about my discussions with the City Attorney's Office in their preparation to defend the City and if I got sued. I believe the prosecutor's questioning about my discussions with the lawyers violated the attorney-client privilege.

- 16. During my time with the federal grand jury, Mr. Durkin questioned me about the "lunge statement" and if I was the one from whom it originated and to whom I had made the statement. I told the grand jury I did not hear the lunge statement that night and the earliest I could have heard it was Sunday night on the news or Monday when I returned to work. Mr. Durkin then said something to the effect that Jody Dewey testified that you are the one that told her about Mr. Zehm's lunging at Ofc. Thompson. I told the grand jury that was not possible.
- testimony, Mr. Durkin asked me in front of the grand jury how I was treated through the process. I told the grand jury that I had been treated horribly and described the circumstances to them. Mr. Durkin walked me out of the grand jury room. As we exited the doors, Mr. Durkin turned around and splashed a thick stapled bundle of papers on to my chest. Mr. Durkin then said, "next time you think I treated you badly, remember I didn't impeach you with this." I looked at the paperwork, asking Mr. Durkin what it was. Mr. Durkin said it was a copy of a lawsuit filed against me for lying to a federal magistrate on a search warrant affidavit. I then recognized the names. I told Mr. Durkin he didn't scare me, so

walked away. I had been dismissed from the lawsuit several years ago.

19. During the early spring 2008, I was assisting Det. Hill, who was following up on a felony assault complaint. Det. Hill was interviewing a female witness where the witness commented that she knew me. The witness said she was one of the two original complainants on the Otto Zehm case who reported themselves as being robbed.

20. I asked her how she was doing and the female responded to me that her interview with the F.B.I as the worst thing in her life. The witness said she was afraid of the F.B.I. and felt they were trying to scare her into changing her statement. The witness said she and her mother called the City Attorney to report what had happened with the F.B.I.
