North Idahoans for Liberty an Idaho PAC Registered to
Idaho Representative Philip L. Hart

Dear Idaho Secretary of State:

I request the Idaho Secretary of State Elections Division and or the Idaho Attorney General investigate Idaho State Representative Philip L. Hart for anomalies found in two Campaign Financial Disclosure Reports. The two disclosures were filed for North Idahoans for Liberty (NIFL), a political action committee, with the Idaho Secretary of State's Office on the following dates:

1. May 18, 2010.
2. June 24, 2010.

Please find a copy of each report attached to this complaint. Both disclosures were certified and executed by Idaho State Representative Philip L. Hart, the NIFL's treasurer.

ANOMALY NUMBER ONE

Please find attached a one page spreadsheet with the title of Campaign Financial Disclosure Reports, North Idahoans for Liberty. You will find that NIFL expended \$ 503.33 more cash than it received. How can NIFL spend more cash than it received?

ANOMALY NUMBER TWO


The June 24, 2010 report states the ending cash on hand is \$ 930.09. Since NIFL spent more then it received in contributions how can it have \$ 930.09 of cash on hand?

The total of the two anomalies is approximately \$ 1,433.42 which when compared to the total cash contributions of \$5,354.30 is an anomaly of about 27%.

Since Representative Hart is a structural engineer, has a Masters of Business Administration from an Ivy League College and is a member of the Idaho House Tax and Rev Committee, anomalies should not be found in his certified campaign financial disclosure reports.

Due to the gross anomalies stated above and the fact that Representative Hart has outstanding State and Federal Tax liens totaling approximately \$700,000.00, as quoted in the attached Idaho Statesman news article, an investigation into Representative Hart's financial dealings should be initiated. An investigation would determine if Representative Hart received unreported income. With an outstanding tax liability of \$700,000.00 that possibility exists. Therefore, I respectfully request that an investigation is opened by either your office or by the Idaho Attorney General.
