This morning our assistant principal heard a rumor that a student brought a weapon to school. With assistance from our security officer, we examined the backpack and in fact, a weapon was found. The student was arrested.

As we investigated further, we spoke with students about their role in protecting our school by reporting rumors and observations and ask you to take this opportunity to talk with your student about the serious consequences of bringing a weapon to school. This would also be a great opportunity to remind your child to do the responsible thing by reporting a sighting of a weapon. It takes all of us – parents, students and staff – working together to keep our schools safe.
