### More Snow through the Holiday Weekend

- First system moving in around noon Thanksgiving Day.
  - Persist into Friday morning.
  - Snowfall amounts will be light (about 2 inches)
- Second and third system Friday afternoon into Saturday.
  - Heavier snowfall will occur generally along and east of a Ritzville to Davenport to Colville line.
  - Worst case 15" for Spokane metro Likely 9" by Saturday night.
  - Rain/Snow mix possible near Lewiston and Pomeroy




## Caution.... Next Slide Warning...

## **Arctic Air Will Weaken Grip**
