

**Edie Brooks resigns as Coeur d'Alene School Board trustee, effective June 30:**

During a special meeting/workshop held Thursday, May 19, 2011, the Board of Trustees accepted the resignation of trustee Edie McLachlan (Brooks), effective June 30, 2011. Mrs. McLachlan (Brooks), newly married, read a prepared letter of resignation citing personal reasons and will be moving away from Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. Mrs. McLachlan (Brooks) had hoped to finish out her term on the school board.

"Your knowledge, experience and background will be sorely missed," stated Superintendent Hazel Bauman. "You have served our community and students well. It is with regret we say goodbye but we congratulate you on the next phase of your life."

Per Idaho Code 33-504, the Board of Trustees passed a motion, declaring the vacancy in Zone 1. This begins the process for the appointment of a trustee to fill the vacancy. Mrs. McLachlan (Brooks) has served the Board representing two zones: Zone 4 from 1996 to 2004 and she was elected to serve as a trustee in Zone 1 in 2006 and has represented Zone 1 since that time.

"You have served with distinction," stated Board member Bill Hemenway. "You have been a devoted proponent of education and I applaud you for never relenting, for standing up for students and the positive impact you have made in our community will be felt for a very long time. Thank you."

The Board requests that interested and qualified patrons who are school district electors residing in Trustee Zone 1 of the Coeur d'Alene School District, submit a letter of interest and resume, naming three references, to the Board of Trustees at 311 N. 10th Street, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83814 by June 3, 2011. Interviews will be scheduled for June 6, 2011.

The newly appointed trustee will serve until the annual meeting in July of 2013 and will continue in that position only if elected in the annual trustee election set by Idaho Code for the third Tuesday in May, 2013.
