The City of Post Falls Water Reclamation Division reported today that a damaged sewer pipe in the Highland's Subdivision has been repaired and there are no reported concerns to public health or safety. The cracked sewer pipe, located at the intersection of Dundee and McDonald Court in the Highland's Subdivision, was reported on Thursday, April 28. The estimated release of wastewater was less than 1,000 gallons. The affected pavement areas were immediately disinfected with bleach and repairs were completed on Friday.

The City immediately informed the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality and the local water companies of the problem. Over the next several weeks, the City will be working with Ross Point Water and Royal Highlands Water Districts to ensure their water supplies continue to be unaffected by the problem. Should testing show any resulting issue, disinfection of the water supply will take place and the public will be notified.

The water is safe and there is no need for the public to take special precautions at this time.
