

TOWN HALL MEETING CONCERNING THE RAW MILK FREEDOM ACT OF 2011

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Legislative Subcommittee of the Kootenai County Republican Central Committee is scheduled to review the following item:

United States House Resolution 1830; To authorize the interstate traffic of unpasteurized milk and milk products that are packaged for direct human consumption.
