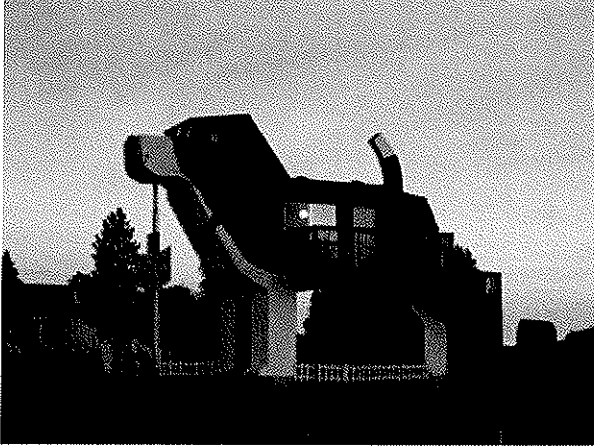


MTV's Cribs episode will feature gigantic Beagle building in Cottonwood

The MTV Cribs series, back this season with the new moniker "Extreme Cribs," will feature the beagle-shaped building at Cottonwood's Dog Bark Park Inn in an episode airing Friday, Aug. 12.

In the cable series family members take viewers on tours of their family's unusual dwelling. The building, which is a bed & breakfast, is owned by Dennis Sullivan and Frances Conklin. Included in the episode are their grandchildren Elizabeth Coen of Johnson, a ninth grader at Pullman High School; and Logan Hudson of Colton, who attends Colton High School.

An eight-member MTV crew filmed the show on a snowy day in March. It was entirely unscripted and took thirteen hours to complete, according to Dog Bark Park's owners.

Guests staying in the B&B beagle enter the dog's body from a second story deck. The head of the dog is a loft room with beds and an alcove in the muzzle. The interior is decorated with chainsaw carvings by Sullivan and Conklin. The building stands beside Highway 95.
