Application for Order Requiring Testimony - 1

As grounds in support thereof, the Government sets forth the following facts
 and circumstances:

3 (1) The said witness, Timothy Moses, has been subpoenaed to testify for
4 the prosecution at the trial of <u>United States v. Karl Thompson</u>, 09-CR-00088-FVS
5 on Thursday, October 20, 2011;

(2) In the judgment of the undersigned, the testimony or other information from said witness may be necessary to the public interest;

(3) We are advised by Mr. Moses's counsel Chris Bugbee that Mr.
Moses' testimony may be inconsistent with sworn testimony that he previously
provided in front of the Grand Jury, in and for the Eastern District of Washington,
on June 16, 2009. It is the United States' understanding that the apparent material
change between Mr. Moses' anticipated and his previously sworn testimony
occurred after having conferred with the Defendant and having later met with
Defendant's counsel while then unrepresented by Mr. Bugbee.

(4) Thus, Mr. Bugbee has advised that absent an order compelling his client's testimony, Timothy Moses is likely to refuse to provide testimony on the basis of the privilege against self-incrimination and will invoke his 5th Amendment right and privilege against self-incrimination;

(5) This application is made with the approval of Roy L. Austin, Jr.,
Deputy Assistant Attorney General (DAG), Civil Rights Division, United States
Department of Justice, pursuant to the authority vested in him by 18 U.S.C.
Section 6003 and 28 C.F.R. 0.175(a). A copy of the letter expressing approval is
