However, neither Matt nor AlliedBarton have the ability to actually PROVIDE “protection details.” That is always provided by Moscow Police Department. We make the arrangements because we help assess the security need and advise the officers at MPD about possible risks.

I mention this because you reference “Matt being nearby” at the next meeting, but I want Matt to know that I am not expecting that of him. We ask MPD because their officers have protective gear, are armed and have arrest authority.
