Brief Overview of Ron Paul's 24-Year Congressional Record:

- ✓ He has never voted to raise taxes.
- √ He has never voted for an unbalanced budget.
- √ He has never voted for a federal restriction on gun ownership.
- √ He has never voted to raise congressional pay.
- √ He has never voted to increase the power of the executive branch.
- ✓ Joined with Butch Otter to vote against the Patriot Act in 2001.
- √ He voted against regulating the Internet.
- √ He voted against the Iraq war.
- ✓ Congressman Paul introduces numerous pieces of substantive legislation each year, probably more than any single member of Congress.

On October 17, 2011, Congressman Paul committed to reducing the presidential salary, starting with himself, to \$39,336 a year, which Paul maintains is about equal to the median personal income of the American worker. He has also proposed legislation to decrease Congressional pay by the rate of inflation.



Is Ron Paul electable?

An August scientific poll of likely voters across the political spectrum by <u>Rasmussen Reports</u> found that in a head-to-head contest between Paul and Barack Obama, the two were "<u>almost dead even.</u>" Obama led Paul by one percentage point at 39% to 38%. Paul has had impressive showings in Iowa, New Hampshire, and Maine.

Because of his wide appeal amongst independent voters, Congressman Paul is likely the only Republican candidate that will be able to defeat Barack Obama. <u>He is certainly the only candidate that will offer substantial government reform</u>. Even if you don't agree with him on every issue, you can be assured that his principled consistency will guarantee that you will know exactly where he stands, and that he truly will do what he says.

These are just some of the reasons why I am endorsing Dr. Paul in his campaign for President, and I'd love to see you do the same.
