MEDIA RELEASE April 17, 2013

On April 17, 2013 at about 3:00 PM, deputies from the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office responded to the intersection of Prairie Ave and Huetter Rd, near Coeur d'Alene for a two vehicle collision.

Once on scene deputies closed Prairie Ave and re-routed traffic around the collision scene. Witnesses to the crash told deputies that a green Ford Explorer was westbound on Prairie Ave at Huetter Rd when a red Honda Accord failed to yield from the stop sign and entered the intersection, striking the Ford Explorer. The force of the collision caused the Explorer to slide sideways and eventually roll over several times.

The Ford Explorer, being driven by Marisol Anguiano, 29 of Post Falls came to a stop on its top in the middle of Prairie Ave. Anguiano and her one and a half year old child were both transported to Kootenai Health. Anguiano received non-life threatening injuries and her child appeared uninjured. The child was buckled in a child safety seat.

The Honda Accord, being driven by Wilbur L. Collins, 52 of Rathdrum came to rest in the eastbound lanes of traffic. Collins was also taken to Kootenai Health for non-life threatening injuries.

The collision is currently being investigated by the KCSO Traffic Team. The roadway was closed for about an hour. Further details are not available at this time.
