## **Endorsement Event Resolution**

## Preamble

Whereas, An important responsibility of the Kootenai County Republican Central Committee (KCRCC) is to promote the Republican philosophy; and

Whereas, Promotion of the Republican philosophy cannot be done while simultaneously supporting candidates who oppose the Republican philosophy; and

Whereas, The KCRCC has failed to show any concern regarding whether or not a Republican candidate has promoted or opposed the Republican philosophy; and

Whereas, This failure has created a vacuum that has been filled by special interest groups and the media, who often obfuscate a candidate's philosophy; and

Whereas, This failure also has created a situation where Republican politicians holding public office have no incentive to promote the Republican philosophy; and

Whereas, It is imperative that the KCRCC correct its past failures by determining a Republican candidate's past willingness to promote the Republican philosophy; and

Whereas, It is equally important to communicate that determination to the Republican voters; and

Whereas, The most effective way to communicate that determination is by way of an official KCRCC endorsement; therefore

## Main Motion

*Resolved*, That the KCRCC urges county candidates who are Republicans to abide by the Party's endorsements.
