## IDP Sets 10-Year Strategic Plan; 2014 IDP Convention in Moscow

Boise, Idaho— Idaho Democrats met for the 2013 Clint Stennett Fall Idaho Democratic Party meeting Friday through Saturday (Oct. 25 – 27) in Twin Falls. Major business entailed establishment of a 10-Year Strategic Plan. IDP leaders also voted to hold the 2014 Idaho Democratic State Convention on June 20 at the Best Western Inn in Moscow, Idaho.
