## **Evan Frasure announces candidacy for Secretary of State**

**Pocatello, Idaho – December 18, 2013** – Evan Frasure, former Idaho Senator, will formally announce his candidacy for the office of Idaho Secretary of State tomorrow, Thursday, December 19. He will make his official announcement in a public ceremony at 11:15 a.m. on the steps of the Bannock County Courthouse.
