MEDIA RELEASE April 15, 2014

The Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is seeking assistance from anyone that may know the whereabouts of Terry Andrew Clark, 25 years old of Coeur d'Alene, ID.

In the early morning hours of April 12, 2014, Clark was attending a large outdoor party in the area of Old Highway 95 and Brunner Rd, south of Athol, ID. During the party, and for an unknown reason, Clark became violent with other party goers.

When deputies responded to the location, most of the attendees had left the area, including Clark, whom reportedly fled the area on foot.

Witnesses and the victims reported that Clark began hitting people with a handgun; four victims were taken to Kootenai Health for treatment, including surgery. All the victims had significant facial injuries that were consistent with the allegations that they were assaulted with an impact type weapon.

A firearm, described by some of the witnesses was recovered and is being held by the Sheriff's Office. Due to the nature of the offense and ongoing investigation, its description is not being made public at this time.

Sheriff's Detectives have obtained a felony warrant for Clark's arrest for four counts of Aggravated Battery. Clark may have fled to the Newport, WA area. He also may be driving either a black 1996 Cadillac Eldorado (Idaho plate: K401606) or a 1998 red Pontiac Grand Am (Idaho plate: K545681).

Anyone with information on Clark's whereabouts is asked to contact the Sheriff's Office. Due to Clark's recent violent behavior, if anyone sees him, please do not approach and instead contact law enforcement. Additionally, any other victims or witnesses that have not been in contact with law enforcement are also encouraged to contact the case detective, Detective Northrup with the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.
