

Post Falls Police Department activity report – 7.20-21.14

Swing & Night Shifts (Sunday/Monday):

Swing and night shift officers responded to 34 calls for service including 5 medical assists, 4 welfare checks, 3 citizen assists, 3 animal calls and 3 drug calls as well as:

A citizen reported suspicious/drug activity at Chase Field. Officers made contact w/ 3 females and a male inside a vehicle. The male was subsequently charged with possession and arrested on an outstanding warrant. One of the females was cited for possession of marijuana.

***This is a great example of how our citizens assist law enforcement by calling in suspicious activity

Officers assisted a citizen who called in a road rage incident. A vehicle in front of him was "brake checking" him. The caller passed the vehicle and the driver followed him through town flashing the headlights. The vehicle turned off before the caller could make contact with an officer and the citizen did not want pursue anything further.

A passerby reported a red car full of juveniles driving up and down the road pulling a juvenile on a skateboard. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle or the juveniles. (JO)

Sunday Day Shift:

Officers responded to 2 malicious injury calls, 2 medical assists, 2 welfare checks, 1 alarm and 1 alcohol offense, as well as:

A 15 year old female was discovered hiding under a vehicle at a residence. She told officers she had run away from home and was going to meet a 19 year old man. The juvenile was returned home to her family.

Officers responded to a reported disturbance. Once on scene it was discovered an adult male was having an argument with his 18 year old son about his son's attitude. Neither party involved wanted to pursue charges and the 18 year old found a different place to stay for the evening.

A citizen reported a group of males down by the beach near Shoreline Drive that were acting suspicious and possibly breaking bottles on the beach. Officers located 5 males throwing rocks into the water but did not locate anything that had been damaged.

Also -- Day Shift:

Officers have responded to 50 calls for service since midnight until now. Some of the details are:

A warrant from Benewah Co was served on a male on Beech St. He was taken into custody without

incident.

We have responded to 14 animal calls today, 4 medical calls, 1 property damage accident, and several other general calls for service.
