

Post Falls Police Department activities, Aug. 9-11, 2014:

Night Shift

Night shift officers handled 2 contained animal calls, 2 DUI calls, 2 welfare checks, 1 disorderly and 1 agency assist as well as:

A cold report involving a juvenile being threatened by another juvenile with a knife.

A physical altercation occurred between a father and his adult son. The father was intoxicated and received a head wound when he hit the ground. He was examined by EMS and cleared, and neither party wanted to pursue charges.

An intoxicated female called to report she had found her dog; however, the call-taker could hear an argument going on. Officers responded for a welfare check and it turned out she was arguing with her adult daughter and everything was ok at the residence.

Officers responded to a residence after a 911 open line call and discovered a physical fight had occurred. There were varying stories from the parties involved and no one wished to pursue charges.

A traffic stop was made for expired tags and the male driver was subsequently arrested for DUI. (JO)

Swing Shift

Officer conducted a traffic stop in the area of Willamette and Chase. The driver was suspended and a report was taken.

Officer was dispatched to Avista Bridge for swimmers trespassing on their property. Upon arrival, he contacted a male who had a confirmed warrant for his arrest. He was taken into custody without incident.
