

Post Falls Police Department activities for Aug. 13-14:

Night Shift:

Night shift officers responded to 23 calls for service including 4 medical assists ,4 phone contacts and 3 welfare checks, as well as:

A mother reported her juvenile son had left the residence after an argument he had with his step father. The juvenile was entered as a missing person, but later removed after he was located by officers and returned home.

We received information about a pink Mongoose bike that was left on N. Chase Rd. The serial number was checked and returned clear and the bicycle was placed in our evidence barn. If you are missing a bicycle please call our evidence department to see if it is yours.

Officers located a male and female in the wooded area off the Centennial Trail near Falls Park. After making contact it was discovered the male had a warrant for a probation violation, and he was taken into custody. The female was given a courtesy transport to her mother's residence.

Swing Shift:

Several minor calls were handled tonight by Swing Shift. Highlight calls from their shift:

Suspicious/Found Property-several hypodermic needles were located in the trash at a local gas mart. The needles were collected and disposed of.

A sex offense between a 9yo and 12yo was reported. The information was taken and the investigation continues.
