

Post Falls Police Department activities report – 9.30.14

Swing & Night Shift:

Swing and night shift officers responded to 40 calls for service including 7 citizen assists, 6 medical assists, 3 traffic offenses and 3 suspicious incidents, as well as:

Officers responded to Garden Plaza for an unresponsive female. When emergency personnel arrived it was confirmed that the 92 year old female was deceased from natural causes.

Day Shift:

Suspicious at WestRidge Elementary- RP stated that there was a white van parked in front of the school and it appeared the male driver was not wearing any clothing. Officers made contact with the male and he was wearing shorts. He stated that he was waiting for his daughter to move her vehicle so he could at her residence.

Suicide Threat at Bob's 21 - Male called the RP and told her that he was going to jump into the river. The RP stated that the male sounded intoxicated. Male was contacted by officers and transported to the hospital for a mental hold.

Threatening on E 2nd - Caller advised that two female adults threatened her 16 year old son after school last Friday. The RP stated that the females were trying to start a fight and chased him threatening to hit him.

Mal-Injury at the Library - Received through text-a-crime reference a suspicious male standing near what appeared to be fresh graffiti. The RP provided a description of the male and his location.

Mal-Injury on E Park Lane - Callers passenger side mirror was smashed and hanging off the vehicle.
