Greensferry Overpass Girder Placements for April 21, 22, and 23, 2015

POST FALLS – Work on the Greensferry Overpass Project will include placement of bridge girders for all three spans of the overpass during the week of April 20 – April 24, 2015. The placement of girders will affect both I-90 and local traffic. The public is advised to take caution in the work zones and expect delays during the following times:

On Tuesday, April 21, 2015, eastbound I-90 will be completely closed from 9:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. for placement of girders over the interstate. Eastbound traffic will be detoured off the interstate at Exit 5 (Spokane Street), be routed along Seltice Way through Post Falls, and back onto I-90 at Exit 7 (Hwy-41).

On Wednesday, April 22, 2015, westbound I-90 will be completely closed from 9:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. Westbound traffic will be detoured off the interstate at Exit 7 (Hwy-41), be routed along Seltice Way through Post Falls, and back onto I-90 at Exit 5 (Spokane Street).

Greensferry Road between Seltice Way and Schneidmiller Avenue currently operates as a one-way street for northbound traffic only with access to the businesses along Greensferry from Seltice Way. On Thursday, April 23, 2015 this portion of Greensferry Road, the intersection of Greensferry and Schneidmiller Avenue, and the most eastern portion of Schneidmiller Avenue will be completely closed for placement of girders. This closure will be from 6:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M. This closure was originally planned to be Monday April 20th, but due to project scheduling has moved to Thursday, April 23, 2015.

The project, which began construction in the fall of 2014, will construct an overpass of Interstate 90 and Schneidmiller Avenue. When completed, the new structure will feature two lanes in each direction, a center turn lane, bicycle lanes, and sidewalks on both sides that connect to the Centennial Trail. The project will improve connectivity, traffic mobility, and emergency response between the business districts and residential areas north and south of the Interstate.
