The memorial services for Coeur d'Alene Police Sergeant Greg Moore will begin Saturday May 9th at 10:00am at Lake City High School located at 6101 N. Ramsey Road. The services are open to the public and the doors are open at 9:00am. North Idaho College, located at 1000 W. Garden Ave. has opened up their Student Union Building with seating capacity of 1000 people. This is an overflow area in which citizens can watch live streaming of the event.

Lake City Community Church located at 6000 N. Ramsey Road has also made arrangements for an overflow area for citizens to watch the services. Public parking for the event will be at the United Methodist Church on Hanley Ave. Signs will direct the public to the parking area.

Citizens can expect long traffic delays on Ramsey Road and Hanley Ave in the early morning hours until the early afternoon. After the services conclude a lengthy procession of law enforcement vehicles will accompany the body of Sgt. Moore to his final resting place at Forest Cemetery. The route will be Ramsey Road south to the four Corners area downtown (Govt. Way, Sherman Ave., Northwest Blvd, and Mullan Ave) north up Government way to Summit Ave. Public viewing is available the entire length of the procession route. Parking in the southbound lane of Government Way from Summit Ave to Garden Ave. will not be allowed after 12:00 am on May 9th and will be closed off with signage.

The internment services are private at the gravesite open only to family and law enforcement. The public and the media are asked to respect the wishes of the family and allow them this time alone with their loved ones.
