The Office of the Governor **Proclamation**

State Capital Boise

WHEREAS, beginning on July 5, 2015 there is an imminent threat to life and property as a result of the Cape Horn Wild Fire, within the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, drought conditions, very dry fuels, and high winds have created this perilous situation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 46-1008 of the <u>Idaho Code</u> do hereby find and therefore proclaim and declare:

- 1. That a state of disaster emergency described in Section 46-1008, <u>Idaho Code</u> exists in the State of Idaho.
- 2. The nature of the emergency is the occurrence and imminent threat to public safety and property arising from the 2015 Cape Horn Fire.
- 3. The state of disaster emergency proclaimed and declared on July 5, 2015 shall exist for a period of thirty days unless terminated, modified or unless extended for thirty-day increments.
- 4. This Proclamation, No. ID-01-2015, 2015 Cape Horn Fire serves pursuant to section 46-1008, <u>Idaho Code</u>, as authorization for the resources of state government to assist in efforts to deal with the disaster emergency of the 2015 Cape Horn Fire.
- 5. That the state of disaster emergency proclamation, No. ID-01-2015, 2015 Cape Horn Fire, shall include the impacted areas within Bonner and Kootenai County, with the State of Idaho.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Idaho at the Capitol in Boise on this 5th day of July, in the year of our Lord two thousand and fifteen and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred fortieth and of the Statehood of Idaho the one hundred twenty-sixth.
