Boise at the IBEW Hall, 225 N. 16th Street

Two candidates are vying for the position:

Dean Ferguson, 46, of Boise, who is the IDP communication director.

Bert Marley, 67, of McCammon, former state senator and 2014 Lt. Gov. candidate.

During the SCC meeting, other candidates can be nominated from the floor. The SCC is made of local party chairs, legislative district chairs, and county state committeemen and state committeewomen. IDP Vice Chair Jeanne Buell has been Acting-Chair since Kenck's resignation at the end of May. Voting members who cannot be at the meetings in person can ask other voting members to carry their proxy votes.
