

Post Falls PD Swing Shift and Graves 05/25-05/26

Officers responded to 42 calls for service between the 2 shifts. Some of the calls included an agency assist, a bank alarm, 6 citizen assists, a found property, 2 suspicious calls, and 3 welfare checks. Below are some of the notable calls for the shift:

16PF10021 Found Property

School bus driver located a 5mm socket on the bus that had been used to smoke Marijuana from. The socket was turned over to Police as found property as it was undetermined who it belonged to. Socket was placed into evidence and report completed.

16PF10029 Warrant

Officers responded to the area of Park Ridge Lp Apts for a wanted person. The male was in the area and had a confirmed warrant for his arrest. Officers located the male hiding behind a dumpster and took him into custody on the warrant. The male was transported to PSB and booked on the warrant.

16PF10047/16PF10055 Shoplifter, Cold report

Officers were dispatched to both Walmart East and West for cold shoplifting reports. AP for both stores advised a male and female came into the stores and stole items. Suspects are the same but stole different items at each store. They were described to be driving a gold colored passenger vehicle. Reports were completed for both.

16PF10056 Theft

Reporting party called advising that he had left his cell phone on the counter at Walmart and when he went back it was no longer there. He stated that someone had to have stolen it. Cell phone was a Samsung Galaxy 5 note. Report completed.

16PF10062: Warrant/MIP

Officers responded to 740 N Cecil for a suspicious call of two males acting strange and possibly being under the influence of narcotics. Officers made contact with both males in which one had a warrant for his arrest. The male (18 YOA) was taken into custody for the warrant and was also cited for MIP alcohol for a bottle of whiskey found in the vehicle. He was transported to PSB without incident.

16PF10067: Unlawful Entry

Officers responded to a missing juvenile who had been missing for approximately an hour. The juveniles mother advised she located her sons skateboard at a friend's house and also discovered the residence back door to be open. Officers checked the residence to make sure there were no intruders inside the residence and it didn't appear anything was taken. The home owner was out of town at the time and nobody was supposed to be in the residence. The juvenile returned home while the officers were securing the residence. The juvenile later admitted to being inside the residence. A report was taken and we are still waiting to hear back from the homeowner.

16PF10070: Mal Injury

While doing a park check at White Pines park, it was discovered the woman's restroom had been vandalized. The sink had been removed from the wall and was sitting on the floor. Report was taken. JLH
