I DECLARE THAT:

I am an inmate at Spokane County jail and I was in a holding cell on April 30, 2009 with Shellye Stark and four other inmates. After Shellye Stark was removed, I had

a conversation with one of the other girls while I was waiting to go to sentencing. This woman was taller (possibly up to 5'9" - 5'10") and thin with olive or darker skin, shoulder length brown hair w/ blonde hi-lights. After S. Stark was removed this girl commented that she knew she recognized her. She then told me that her father was a juror on S. Stark's case. She said her Dad told her that she was convicted because there was no proof that S. Stark was abused and there was 5 bullets in his back. The father also said that the husband was running away + she put 5 bullets in his back. This woman continued to tell me that her father discussed details of the case during the trial "even though he wasn't supposed to". This woman also said the jurors didn't believe S. Stark. CNW

I would be willing to take a polygraph to show that the above is true. CNW
