

Tim White gets pay cut at UC-Riverside

Former University of Idaho President Tim White is among the 10 University of California chancellors who will take a 5-percent pay cut next year, according to an article in the Los Angeles Times.

White resigned from the UI presidency last May, leaving a final year salary of \$286,187 for a \$325,000 salary at the University of California-Riverside.

University of California President Mark Yudof announced the top-level pay cuts in an internal memo on Friday, according to the Times.

White still will receive a vehicle allowance and on-campus residence, but his salary will be \$308,750 next year.

White will receive a smaller salary next year than incoming UI president Duane Nellis, who will receive \$335,000.
