2. I am employed as a police officer for the City of Spokane Police

Department (SPD). I currently hold the rank of Detective and work in the Special

Investigations Unit.

- 3. In 2006, I participated in the investigation of the March 18, 2006 events when asked by Detective Terry Ferguson to review reports and offer information about baton training and use of baton by officers dealing with Otto Zehm.
- 4. One day in 2008, I spoke to Assistant City Attorney Rocco N.

 Treppiedi in passing about the claim against the City; he said he wanted to review my report with me in detail at his office in the near future, and I gave him my general schedule.
- 5. A few days later, I received a subpoena from the U.S. Attorney's Office to testify before a Grand Jury. I was told by Lisa Janguard that I should not talk to anyone about the subpoena. Mr. Treppiedi contacted me afterwards and I told him I was directed not to talk to anyone about the case. He informed me that he did not hear about the subpoena or order, but that it would not include lawyers for the City or my own lawyer, and that he'd call the Chief's office to find out what was going on. He called me back and said I should talk to Assistant Chief Nicks. I spoke with Chief Kirkpatrick and Assistant Chief Nicks and was authorized to talk to Mr. Treppiedi about my report and any other matter involving my work in confidence with him as my attorney. I did so.
