3. On 02/22/10 at approximately 0850 hrs., I was traveling westbound on W. Fairway Dr from the intersection of W. Appleway Ave., on my way to an appointment. While driving, I observed a silver passenger car in front of me jerking from side to side in both lanes of travel. The erratic driving caught my attention and I requested an registration inquiry from Central Dispatch. While waiting for the return, I observed the car turn west onto W. Masters Dr. without activating it's turn signal. Due to the traffic infraction and the driving pattern, I had Central Dispatch cancel my request and I initiated a traffic stop to find out why the driver was operating the car in the manner I reported.

After turning onto W. Masters Dr., I activated my emergency lights approximately 200 feet from W. Fairway Dr.. I then observed the car continue to jerk towards the right side of the road. After approximately 200 more feet I activated my siren after the car failed to yield. The car then began to accelerate as we approached the first curve. Due to the car accelerating, I called for a cover unit over the radio air. As central Dispatch acknowledged my request, the silver car accelerated quickly to approximately 50 M.P.H. around the second curve causing the tires of the car to slide on the road. Immediately after the curve, the silver car pulled into the driveway located at 2907 W. Masters Dr.. As the car pulled into the driveway, I observed the driver side door open and a male wearing light colored pants, a black zip up sweatshirt with white designs on it, jump out of the moving car. The male then ran east down a hill and behind a house located at 2903 W. Masters Dr.. I then parked my car and opened my door. I pulled out my issued side arm and announced myself as the police and to stop. The male did not stop and continued to run. I then ordered the passenger in the front passenger seat to show me his hands. While doing this, I observed the silver car gain momentum as it rolled down a hill. The car then collided into the west side of the house located at 2903 W. Masters Dr..

As I held the passenger at gunpoint, I updated Central Dispatch of the situation. Within several minutes, M1- Dep. Franssen and M2- Dep. Campbell arrived and assisted me in placing the passenger in handcuffs and clearing the silver car.

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While we were securing the car, M3- Dep. Hunt and several other officers from other departments arrived in the area and began to search for the driver.

I then went and spoke with the passenger. I read the passenger Miranda, confirmed he understood his rights, and he wished to speak to me. I then identified the passenger as W- Frank F. James. James told me the following in summary: His friend "[REDACTED]" and he had just dropped off James' kids at school and were enroute to a girl's house near Atlas x Hanley. When he noticed my emergency lights on behind them, the driver said, "Fuck, fuck fuck." James said the driver then asked James what he should do. James told me he did not respond and the driver pulled into the above address where he took off running. He has no idea why the driver ran.

While I was speaking with James, Central Dispatch advised me they had a report of a man hiding behind a hot tub located at 3217 W. Fairway Dr.. The reporting party said she confronted the male who then ran off through the golf course wearing light colored pants and a black coat. Dep. Hunt responded to the area and spoke with the resident at the house. There was no further important information provided.

Dep. Franssen and I completed a Vehicle Inventory Form for the silver car. While conducting the inventory, Dep. Franssen located two documents with writing on them. One document said the name "[REDACTED]" and "My address [REDACTED]". The other document was from Rent-A-Center. The document contained the name [REDACTED] a date of birth, address, phone number, and social security number.

I later placed the two document into KCSO Evidence.

M4- Sgt. Smart then arrived at my location and I informed him of the situation. Sgt, Smart contacted the owner of the damaged house and provided them proper contact information for the crash.

M5- Trooper Keys arrived and completed a crash report. Case #10-0432.

I then went and spoke with James again. I released James from his handcuffs. James then completed a voluntary witness statement form. See attached form.

While I was speaking to James, Dep. Franssen photographed the car and the crash scene. See Dep. Franssen's supplemental report and photographs.

I had Central Dispatch attempt to contact the registered owner of the car to find out the status of the car. No contact was able to be made. Trooper Keys had ISP dispatch call Merwin's Towing on my request. Merwin's Towing arrived and took custody of the car. See Trooper Key's impound form.

After the car was removed, I examined the damage to the house. The car penetrated into the interior of the house breaking the siding about 4 feet wide and 3 feet tall. Several support beams were also snapped in half.

Dep. Hunt researched [REDACTED] in the KCSO in-house computer system. Dep. Hunt found a person by the name of S- [REDACTED] showed he had an active warrant for his arrest and a suspended license. His name file also had a previous booking photograph of him. I then showed the photograph to James who confirmed the Driver was [REDACTED] three times. [REDACTED] said the picture looked like him only heavier.

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After I Left the scene, I drove back to where I had activated my emergency lights. The total distance was 0.3 miles long. I also observed fresh tire tracks where the silver car had slid on the road.

Dep. Campbell and I later checked the listed home address for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] family members said they kicked him out of the house before the holidays due to his drug use and lifestyle. They advised they would call me if they hear from him.

Dep. Campbell and I then went to James' residence. James advised he thought he would have heard from [REDACTED] by now but had not.

Note: James appeared to be lying to me on several occasions and providing me with false information about [REDACTED]. When I asked him if he was lying, James said he did not want to provide me with information that would help prosecute [REDACTED]. On the second contact at James' House, James appeared to be under the influence of a narcotic. His eyes would shut while speaking to me as if he was falling asleep. James could not focus and forgot simple questions/instructions. Through my training and experience, I recognized these as symptoms of narcotic use.

I attempted to contact [REDACTED] via known telephone numbers. Both went straight to voicemail. I left messages requesting contact.

I completed a Complaint request against [REDACTED] for violations of I.C. 49-1404(2)(b) Eluding a police officer causing damage, I.C. 49-1301 Leaving the scene of a damage accident, and I.C. 18-705 Resisting and Obstructing a police officer. See attached from.
