RAUL LABRADOR FILLS IN FOR CONGRESSWOMAN MICHELLE BACHMANN
AT RNC's FIRE PELOSI SPEAKING SERIES

Wednesday, Washington, DC- Raul Labrador, the Republican nominee chosen by Idaho's voters to retake Idaho's 1st Congressional District, addressed a group of national Republicans at the "Fire Pelosi" Speaking Series. Labrador, speaking at the Republican National Committee headquarters, was asked to fill in for scheduled keynote speaker Congresswoman Michelle Bachmann.



Labrador's speech focused on the importance of volunteering, being active in our communities, and working hard in Republican races, so Republicans can strip the gavel of power from House Speaker Nancy Pelosi.
