# More Snow through the Holiday Weekend

- ▶ First system moving in around noon Thanksgiving Day.
  - ▶ Persist into Friday morning.
  - ▶ Snowfall amounts will be light (about 2 inches)
- ▶ Second and third system Friday afternoon into Saturday.
  - ▶ Heavier snowfall will occur generally along and east of a Ritzville to Davenport to Colville line.
  - ▶ Worst case 15" for Spokane metro – **Likely 9"** by Saturday night.
  - ▶ Rain/Snow mix possible near Lewiston and Pomeroy



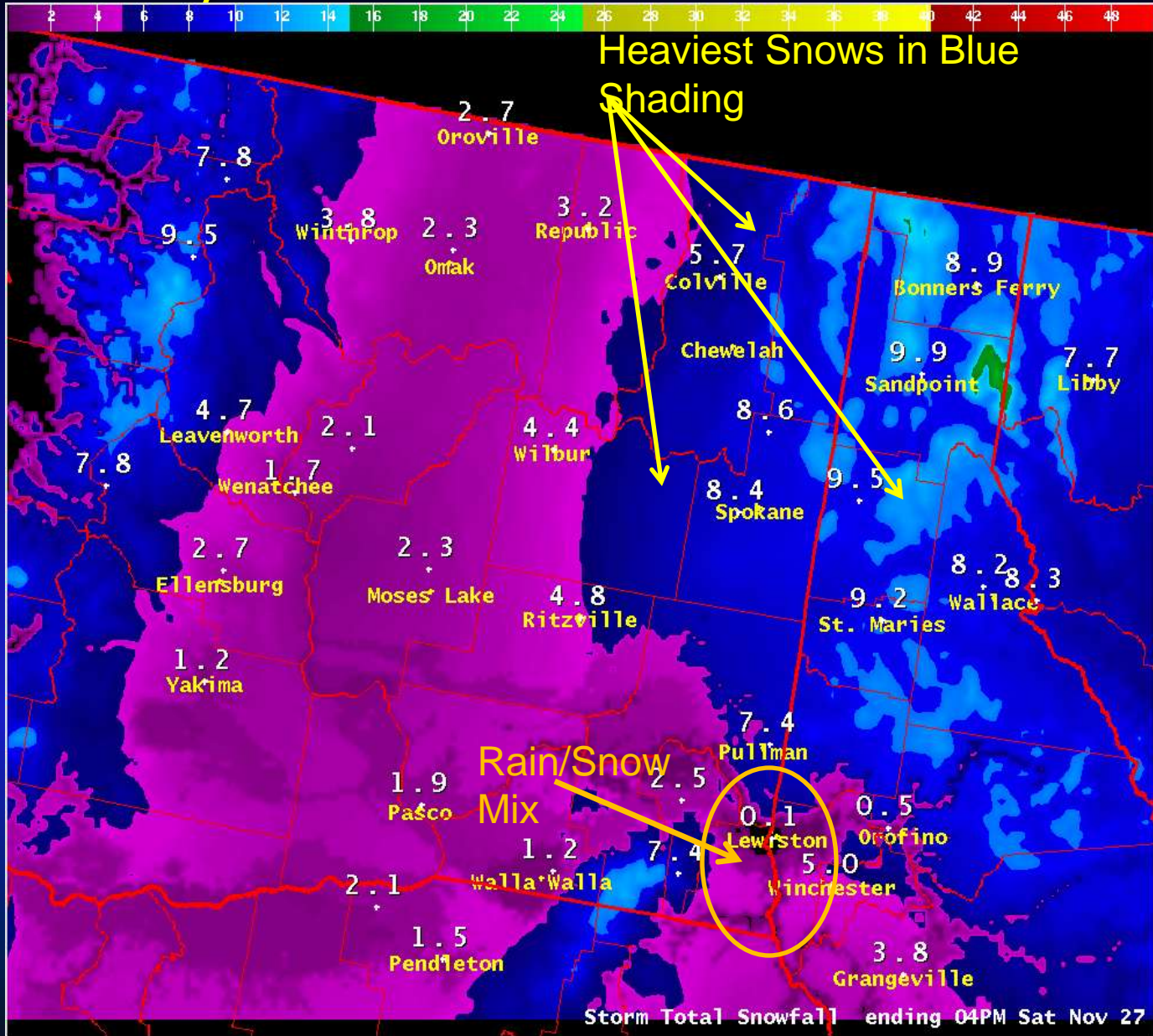

# Arctic Air Will Weaken Grip

- ▶ Temperatures will gradually “warm” into the 20s beginning Thanksgiving.
- ▶ Travel impacts from additional snow expected
- ▶ Travel along 95 south of Winchester may become treacherous if freezing rain occurs
