THE UNDERSIGNED MAKES THE FOLLOWING DECLARATIONS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTY FOR PERJURY AND SAYS: That I am a peace officer with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Clark County, Nevada, being so employed for a period of 2 years.

That I learned the following facts and circumstances which lead me to believe that MURRY, ROY committed (or was committing) the offense of Carrying Concealed Weapon - Firearm at the location of Pebble Road and Pebble Road, Las Vegas, NV 89123.

That the offense occurred at approximately 0220 hours on the 24th day of January, 2011.

On 11-24-2011 at approximately 0201 hours I Officer J. Campbell, P # 13150 and Officer J. Parker, P # 12936 were operating as marked patrol unit 1DP14. I observed a dark colored Honda four door vehicle bearing Washington License plate 4572PH with it's lights on and on the side of the road. The vehicle was parked at an odd angle to the roadway. The area had "No Parking" signs posted. As I approached the vehicle I noticed the engine was running and I observed a white male occupant who was sitting in the drivers seat of the vehicle. The male was later identified as Murry, Roy, DOB: [REDACTED]. Murry was asleep with his chin down on his chest and his head forward resting against the steering wheel. Murry was visibly drooling from the mouth a brown liquid which was later found to be chewing tobacco. Murry also had a cell phone in his lap.

Through the windows of the vehicle Officer Parker noticed several military style jackets and backpacks. She also observed several boxes of rifle and handgun ammunition. Officer Parker also noticed a bullet proof military style vest with several rifle magazines. I knocked on the window of the vehicle and tried to wake up Murry. After approximately one minute of hard knocking Murry regained consciousness slowly. Murry did not comply with my commands to roll the windows down nor put his hands on the steering wheel. I then opened the door to the vehicle and continued to give him commands. After I was able to get Murry to put his hands on the steering wheel I asked him if he had any firearms in the vehicle. Murry stated "Yes in the trunk, in a case". I then ordered Murry out of the vehicle to conduct a pat down for weapons.

While conducting a pat down for weapons I felt a large metal object in Murry's waistband on his right hand side. I immediately recognized it was a firearm and asked Murry what it was. Murry stated "my gun". I then placed Murry into handcuffs and recovered the handgun from his waistband. The firearm was inside his waistband and utilized a slide mounted clip to secure it to his pants. The way the waistband clip is mounted to the firearm it conceals the entire forward portion of the firearm inside Murry's pants. Murry was also wearing a large jacket which overlapped over his pants and completely concealed the firearm from outside view. The firearm located was a Springfield Armory XD-9 Sub-Compact 9MM handgun, serial number: US888611. The firearm was booked into evidence.

While finishing my pat down I located two knives and two magazines of ammunition on Murry's person. Murry also had several rounds of loose ammunition in his pockets. Murry had an ankle holster on his right lower leg but it was empty.

Due to the above facts and circumstances, which show that Murry did carry upon his person, a firearm, which would not be observable to ordinary observation, Murry is placed under arrest for Carrying a Concealed Weapon - Firearm and booked into CCDG accordingly. Due to the fact that Murry was also asleep in public he is also charged with Sleeping in Public.

Wherefore, Declarant prays that a finding be made by a magistrate that probable cause exists to hold said person for preliminary hearing (if charges are a felony or gross misdemeanor) or for trial (if charges are misdemeanor).
