Re: Immunity Authorization for Timothy Moses

Dear Mr. Ormsby:

The purpose of this letter is to provide authorization for you to seek an order compelling Timothy Moses to provide testimonial evidence during trial of United States v. Karl Thompson, in the Eastern District of Washington on or after October 20, 2011.

Upon consideration of your request, I find, with the concurrence of Lanny A. Breuer, Assistant Attorney General for the Criminal Division, that testimony from Timothy Moses is necessary to further the public interest. I further find that Mr. Moses, upon the advice of counsel, will likely assert their Fifth Amendment right not to incriminate himself, and that he will likely not provide testimony without compulsion.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me by 18 U.S.C. § 6003 and 28 C.F.R. § 0.175, I hereby authorize you to apply to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Washington for an order requiring Mr. Moses to testify during the trial of United States v. Karl Thompson on or after October 20, 2011.
