All anglers interviewed enjoyed their fishing experience, with average harvest per angler of 3.86 fish. Catch per angler was 6.7 fish. Fishing was very good for carry over rainbow trout, with numerous rainbows observed in the 14-16 inch range. The spring rainbow catchable plant also was well represented in the creel. Brown trout represented @ 11% of the total harvest. Largest fish = 17 inch rainbow trout.
