**ORDER**

As directed by the Memorandum Decision and Order issued by Federal Judge B. Lynn Winmill on September 12, 2013 in Case No. 3:13-CV-348-BLW the following acts are prohibited by Omega Morgan on portions of the U.S. Highway 12, as described in this order and shown on the attached map. These restrictions become effective immediately and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

*Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the Order. 36 CFR 261.54 (A)*

**LOCATION**


The Road closure is described as follows: US Highway 12 from Mile Post 75.2 at the East Kooskia Bridge (T32N, R4E, S4 Boise Meridian) to Mile Post 174.4 at the Idaho-Montana State line (T38N, R15E, S16 Boise Meridian).

**VEHICLE LIMITATIONS**

Any vehicle meeting any of the following criteria is prohibited:

1. Exceeds 16 feet wide or 150 feet long, or
2. Any over-legal vehicle (per Idaho Transportation Department regulation) that requires longer than 12 hours to travel through the Wild and Scenic River Corridor and National Forest (mile posts 75.2 to 174.4), or
3. Requires physical modification of the roadway or adjacent vegetation to facilitate passage beyond normal highway maintenance.

**RATIONALE:** These restrictions are promulgated by Federal Court Order.

**PENALTY:** Violation of this order is prohibited by provisions of the regulations cited, and under USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571. Any violation is subject to punishment by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office and each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
