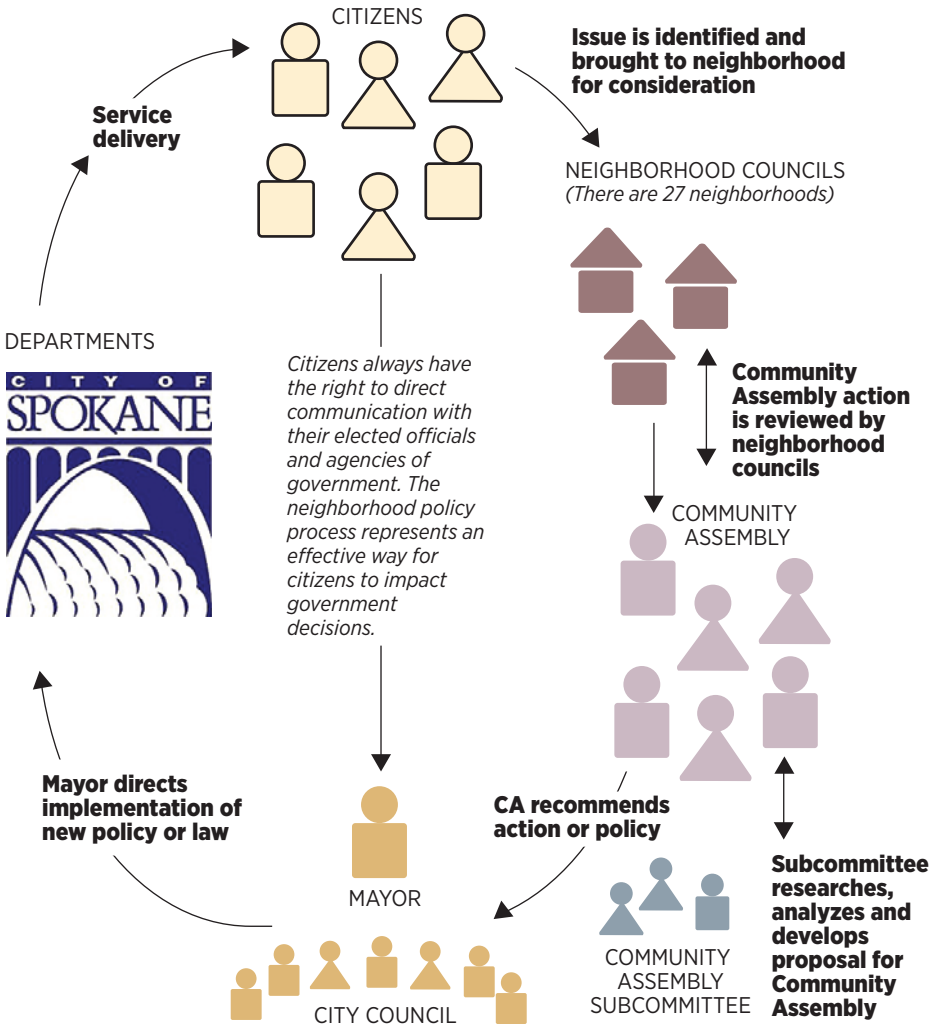


Neighborhood Policy Process

Neighborhood councils comprise volunteers who elect a chairman and other officers among themselves. Bylaws vary but a property owner in a neighborhood typically qualifies as a voting member if he or she is at least 16 years old and attends three neighborhood council meetings within six months.
