

Alicia Troye files for Coeur d'Alene School Board Zone 3 seat

Alicia Troye, 41, of Coeur d'Alene, officially filed paperwork today to run for Coeur d'Alene School District 271 School Board Trustee Zone 3, a seat currently filled by Terri Seymour.

Troye, a Coeur d'Alene resident since 2001, is an active member of the community. She has coached cross-country at Sorensen Magnet Elementary, is an involved member of PTO, volunteers weekly for the CDA Backpack Program and is a member of the planning team for Idaho Youth Ranch's summer fundraiser, Wine, Women & Shoes.

"Considering my recent time in the classroom, I am running for School Board with the teachers in mind and the students at heart," said Troye. "I have experienced first hand the day to day determination teaching requires and to be able to sit on a board that supports success in both teachers and students is a win-win for me. I listen to my neighbors, I am living through school experiences everyday and to have this opportunity to serve the community is an honor."

Troye lives in Coeur d'Alene Place with her husband, Jason, their 2 daughters, who currently attend Sorensen Elementary and their dog, Bodie.

Troye was born in Michigan, where her dad was an FBI agent and her mom, a school-teacher. "My mom loved teaching, it was her passion. Between her love for kids and my dad's need for discipline, my mid-west values were instilled at a young age. Education was important. Rules were respected and followed. These are characteristics I want our students to learn now and carry with them for the rest of their lives."
