~~In regard to the Cotton/Straub PRRs, attached are the records that are available for release pending legal review. I am aware of no other forthcoming records, except for the pending email reviews and except for whatever records may be compiled by Nancy Isserlis in response to the Mary Schultz PRR, which may or may not be responsive to the various media and Breen requests depending on the date of the records compiled.~~

~~We have a follow up due tomorrow on the media requests.~~

~~With respect to the Breen appeal of redactions made, a response is due today. I also have a follow up due to him on the 30th with respect to any records located and to provide further clarification on the Napolitano text messages.~~

~~Here is a description of the records attached:~~

- ~~- The first six attachments are draft offer letters located by Brian Coddington.~~
- ~~- The next three Excel attachments labeled "Cell Phone Records" are the records obtained by IT from Cotton and Mayor cell phones. Straub is not attached as I located no responsive records in the provided data on the Straub CD. I will bring the CDs over for your reference and review.~~
- ~~- The file labeled "Copy of Patrick Erickson..." was provided by John Walters and this spreadsheet contains the desk phone log of calls of Cotton – Mayor - Straub. I highlighted the responsive information I was able to locate in blue.~~

- ~~- The email attachment labeled "Public Records Request" contains the data IT staff was able to obtain through Verizon. Orin had sent me other files previous to the ones reflected in this email, but the other files consisted of all calls/texts rather than those that are the subject to the records requests. In looking at the records that Orin first provided me, I noticed that one of the calls did not appear on the new spreadsheets he provided me, so I went ahead and extracted that particular call data from the previously provided Excel spreadsheet and pasted it into a new spreadsheet which is labeled "Call Details 509.710.400 Dave Condon – 2.xls.xlsx." With respect to the responsive information I was able to locate I changed the font to red or blue so it would stick out.~~
