This past Saturday night, August 3rd, two separate vandalism incidents occurred at my home. There is a large amount of damage and this will financially affect us. I believe you will understand that I will not place my family in harm.

Due to all of these separate, yet possibly linked, circumstances I am forced to take action and protect my family and home. I hereby immediately resign as Harrison Mayor.
